Brooklynbased contemporary artist Sollins exhibits layered constructions that examine how American pastimes—camping, rafting and music—relate to the search for meaning. Also on display, "The Artist's Hand: Willem de Kooning Drawings, 1937 to 1954." Check out works by De Kooning that are on public view for the first time, including his earliest known self-portrait (circa 1938) and drawings from the explosive "Woman" series of the early 1950s.
